A Guide to contacting your MP

We want to make sure every MP knows about and shows support for the Missing Medicines campaign. Here's a clear breakdown of the steps you need to take:

Step 1 Find out who your MP is. You can find out at

Step 2 Edit '[Letter 1 – To Your MP](#)' This is the email/letter you will send to your MP. Make sure to add yours and their details, as well as your own personal message!

Step 3 Edit '[Letter 2 – To the Secretary of State for DFID](#)' This is the email/letter you will attach to Letter 1 which will be sent to your MP, asking them to then send this onto Priti Patel (Secretary of State for International Development) and Jeremy Hunt (Secretary of State for Health) '[Letter 3 – To the Secretary of State for Health](#)'

Step 4 Send both completed letters to your MP. This can be done in a number of ways - print them out and send by post, email directly to your MP or write it by hand. This is your chance to get creative and make sure your letter stands out, so feel free to add photos, personal experiences and stories to it.

Step 5 Send a copy, or BCC, Saoirse@stopaids.org.uk so we can keep track of which MPs have been contacted and we can support you with follow-up meetings.

Tip: If they don't reply within a week, give them a call to follow-up and check if they've got it. Try and get a meeting organised. If you get a meeting organised, drop Saoirse an email (Saoirse@stopaids.org.uk) so she can support you!
